
Connecting Your Tablet to Wi-Fi

In this lesson we will look at connecting to the internet using Wi-Fi or wireless internet. Before going ahead make sure you are in an area where there is Wi-Fi available, you know the name of the network and that you have the password to access it


All tablets are slightly different so may not look exactly the same as the one we've used as an example in this booklet but the method should remain the same

Connecting To Wi-Fi


1. Tap once on the “All Apps” button at the bottom centre of the screen.



2. Locate the “Settings” app which should look like a cog similar to this one (you may need to swipe left or right to access further apps if you can’t immediately see it):



3. You should come to a screen similar to this with Wi-Fi being the first option. If it isn’t already highlighted tap on it now




The screen may look different on your tablet but just look around for a button or section that says “Wi-Fi” and tap on it

Connecting Your Tablet To Wifi


5. Locate the Wi-Fi network you want to connect to - it will have a unique name. Tap on it once.




6. A box should appear that looks similar to this. If the keyboard does not immediately appear, tap into the box beside "Password"



7. Type in the password for the network. It will appear as dots for security so make sure you type it in very carefully, ensuring that you enter lower and upper case letters where appropriate. Then press "Connect".



8. The box should disappear and shortly you should see that the network is connected.



Press the "Back" button until you return to the home screen.



You should now be connected to the internet and able to use apps like Chrome, Skype, Facebook, Bus Tracker etc. If you come back to the same building and the Wi-Fi network you connected to in the lesson is working it will automatically reconnect so you don't have to go through the procedure again
