## Installing And Uninstalling Apps On Your Amazon Kindle

In this lesson we will look at installing an app on your Amazon Kindle. Most Amazon Kindles do not have apps like Skype pre-installed so you may have to use App Store to locate and install them yourself. In this guide we will show you how to do this.

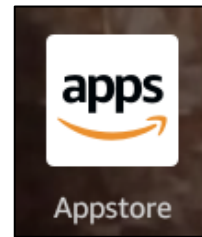
In this example we are going to install Skype but the same will apply to any app you want to install.

## Lesson 1: Accessing “App Store”

1. Locate the “App Store” app which should look similar to this one (you may need to swipe left or right to access further apps if you can’t immediately see it)



2. The app should open and look something like this (the “Top Grossing” apps change daily).

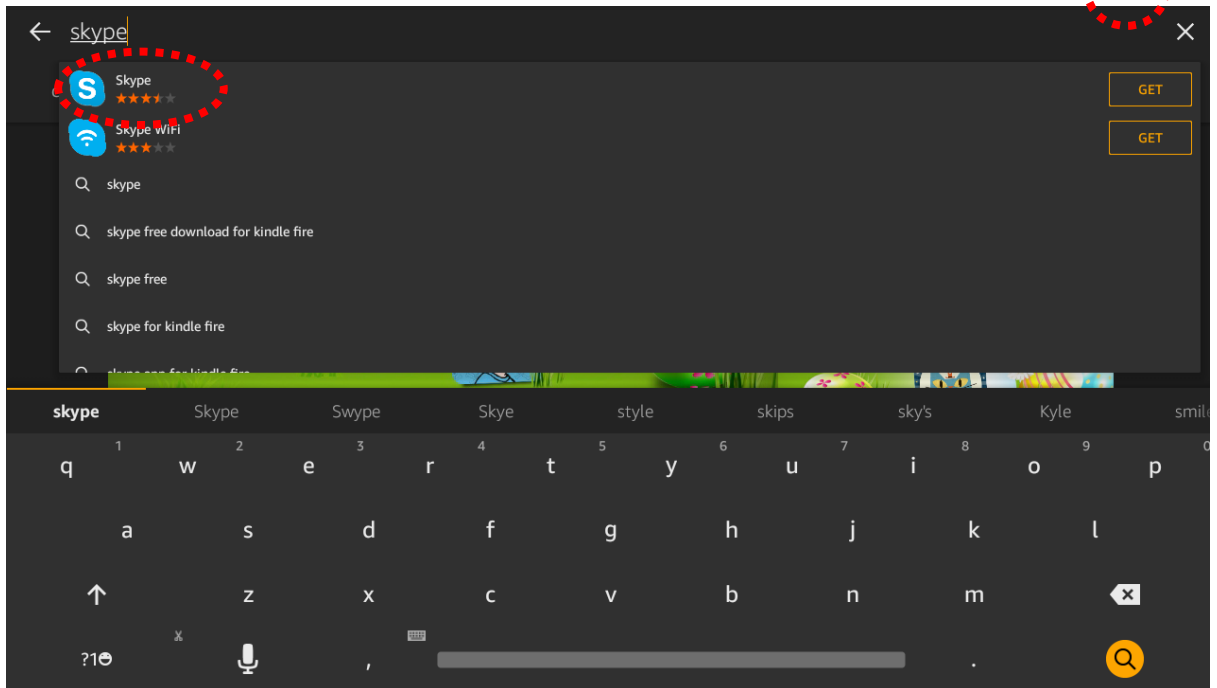


## Lesson 2: Searching For And Installing An App

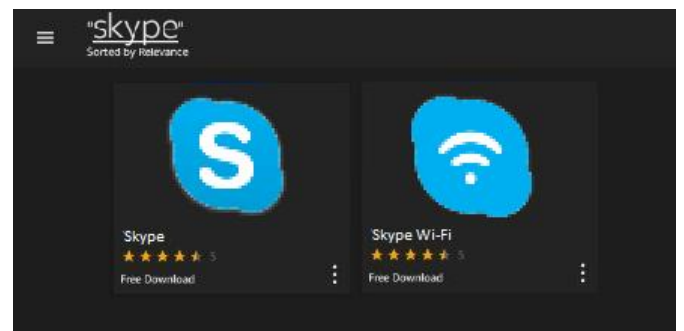
1. To search for an app, tap on the magnifying glass at the top right of the screen.



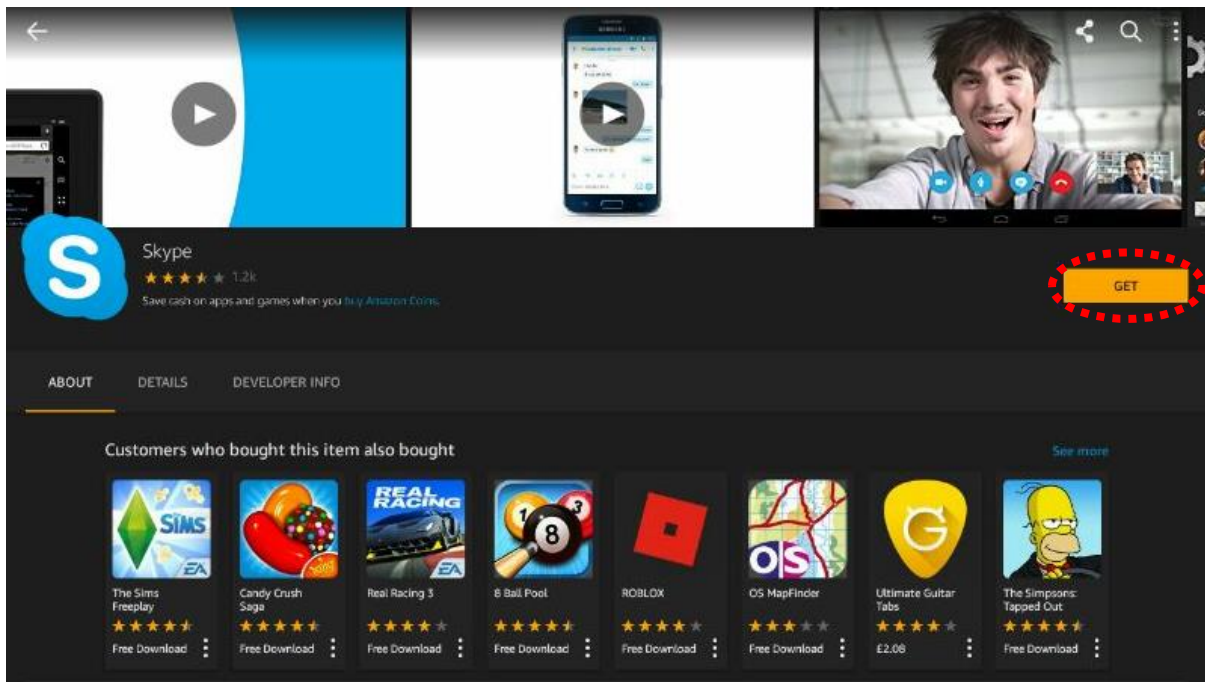
2. When the keyboard appears type “Skype” and press the magnifying glass key on the keyboard.



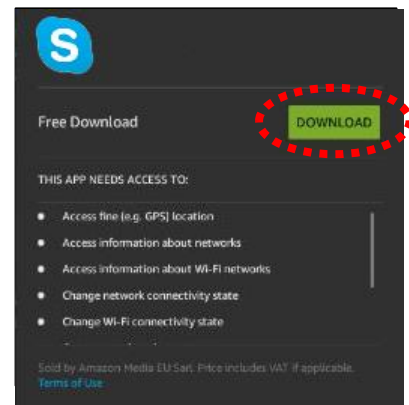
3. You should shortly come to a page with the results of your search. The first result is usually the one that you're looking for but it will also show any apps that are relevant to your search. Tap on the big “S” (not on the Skype Wi-Fi)



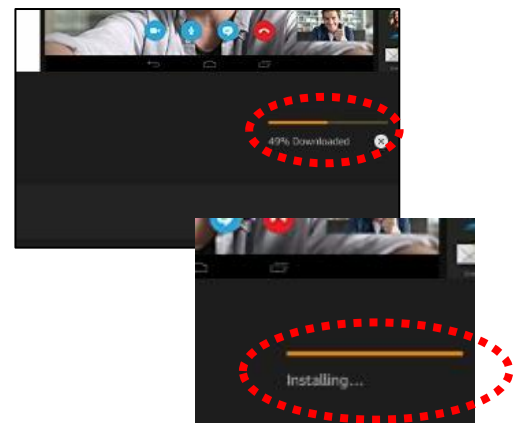
4. You will come to a summary page for Skype with ratings and details. Tap on little button that says “GET” at the far left.



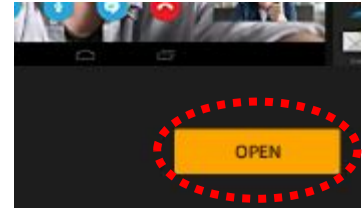
5. A little box should appear at the centre of the screen, tap on the green “Download” button.



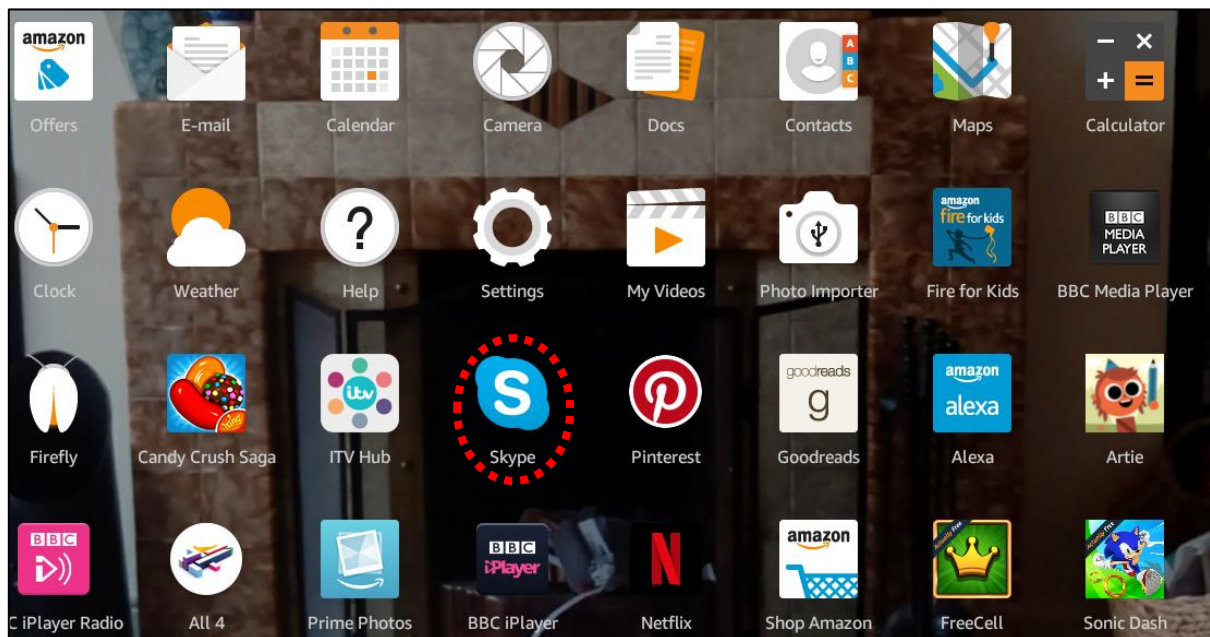
6. The box should disappear and you'll see a line appear at the left of the screen showing the progress of the “download”. When it reaches 100% it should change to “Installing”



7. Once the install completes a button that says “OPEN” will appear. This means that the app is now completely installed on your Amazon Kindle. Hit the “HOME” button.

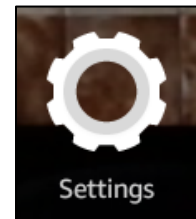


1. Your Amazon Kindle should automatically put an icon for the app on the home screen BUT it may place it on the additional screen down the screen. If you can't see it, swipe upwards on the home screen and you should see it. If you tap it once the app should open.

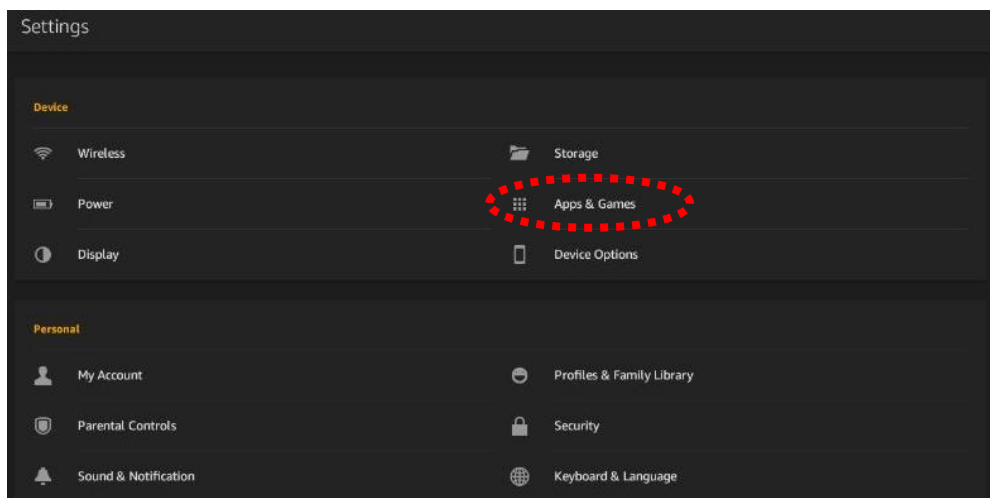


## Lesson 4: Uninstalling An App

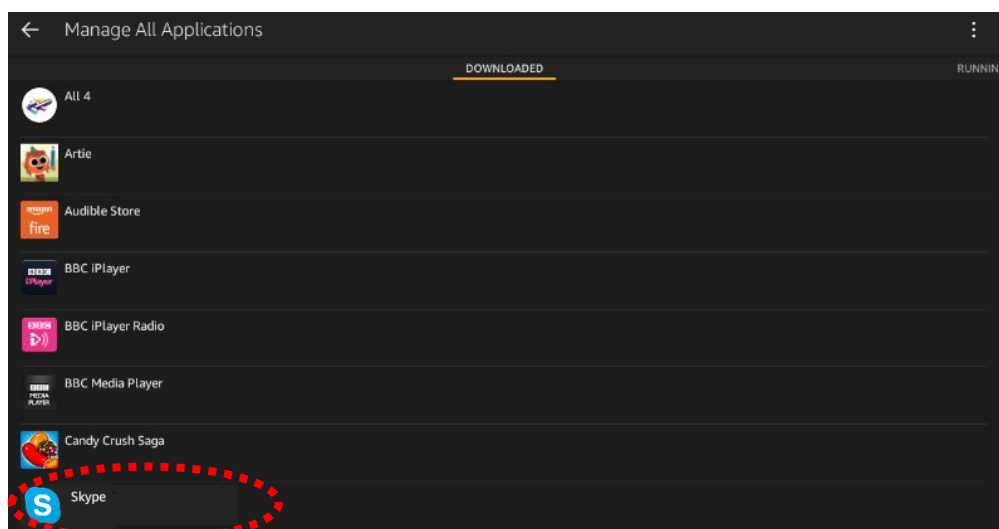
1. Locate the “Settings” app which should look like a cog similar to this one (you may need to swipe left or right to access further apps if you can’t immediately see it):



2. You should come to a screen similar to this. Find the option for “Apps and Games” and tap it once.



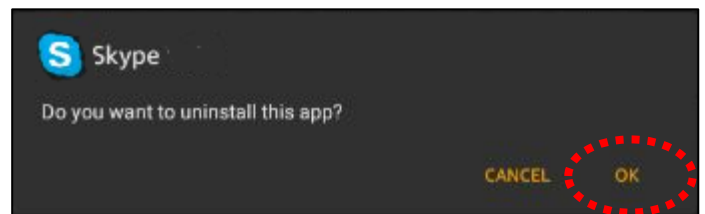
3. The “Manage All Applications” section should appear and look similar to this. It’s in alphabetical order so you may have to swipe down the list until you see “Skype”. Tap on it.



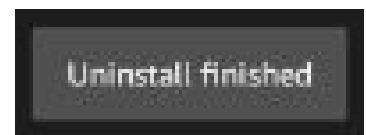
4. You'll now be taken to a screen that gives you information about the app (how much data it uses etc). Tap on the "Uninstall" button.



5. When the box appears asking if you are sure you want to uninstall press "OK"



6. After a few seconds a little box should appear that says "Uninstall Finished"



7. Press the "Back" button until you get to the home screen.
